

National Church Leader Conference in Sudan Sponsored by Mount Pisgah



"It is like living with a noose around your neck." It was my first night in Sudan. I had asked Pastor Andrew what it was like being a pastor in Sudan. This was his response due to the constant persecution of the church in Sudan by their Muslim government. During the past 20 years, over 2 million people in Sudan have died as a result of war, genocide, and famine. One pastor shared how a bomb landed on his doorstep but the blast went away from his home as God protected his wife and three children. Despite intense persecution, Pastor Andrew and the other pastors praised God for how He has used this time of persecution to grow His church in Sudan! **Wow, what an amazing faith!!**

During the week of Jan 21, Mount Pisgah invested in training 60 church leaders from around Sudan in partnership with ILI, FamilyChurch, and the Winshape Foundation. These 60 leaders learned important principles of biblical leadership, how to create a vision and set goals, etc. By the end of the week, these national church leaders were so excited about this training that they had planned another 20 conferences around the country over the next 6 months for the purpose of training another 800 church leaders! Many of these leaders had new visions for how to reach Muslims for Christ, plant new churches, minister to orphan children, etc. These church leaders are impacting the lives of thousands of believers around Sudan and leading many to Christ. At Mount Pisgah, we are blessed to partner with these brothers and sisters in Christ who are giving their lives completely to the Lord's work despite their difficult life circumstances.
