Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. TAKE AWAY

Jesus is the Creator and Redeemer of humanity. He is the Ruler of God's Kingdom as all authority is given to Him.

The fact that Jesus has all authority has two implications on us: He expects us to do what he asks and that He fully supports us when we do.





THE HYMN WRITER PUT IT ANOTHER WAY:



1. There are people in your life that need YOU to obey Jesus and be a guide for them.

2. Obedience to Jesus' commands must be driven by Love, NOT by force, guilt, or compliance.

3. Becoming a teacher for Jesus is done over time with steady and intentional investment; and everyone can do it through the help of the Holy Spirit.

4. Being part of a small disciple group - discussing Jesus' commands and learning how to obey them and eventually teach them creates a "Greenhouse Effect"—which is essential to help transform you into a confident and joyful disciple maker.


